Upperclassmen move in to Rowan Boulevard apartments

The second phase of apartments on Rowan Boulevard officially opened today, marking the completion 886-bed project. The first phase opened last fall with 560 beds.

Situated at the corner of Route 322 and Main Street near the roundabout on the edge of campus, the apartment suites boast full kitchens, living room common areas, two bathrooms and four single-occupancy bedrooms. The complex also includes multi-purpose rooms, exercise and weight-training rooms, laundry facilities on every floor, and a public safety substation with 24-hour coverage.

The price tag for living in the brand new apartments is \$8,944 a year — about \$2,000 more than what upperclassmen pay to live in some of the older apartments on campus.

Rowan University President Donald Farish, who toured the new apartments on Monday and spoke to students as they moved in, said the opening marks yet another milestone in the university and borough's plans to create a quintessential college town.

"This creates an opportunity for juniors and seniors to have living conditions that are as good as could be and are still be adjacent to campus," Farish said.

The housing was built and is owned by Sora Holdings, LLC, the developer of the \$300 million revitalization project. When complete, Rowan Boulevard will also include a new hotel and conference center, retail stores and restaurants as well as office and residential space. Developers expect it will infuse the local economy with more than \$225 million annually.



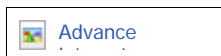
